Principal's Message

At Mountain View we are concerned for the safety of all students and staff. We are here to learn, and learning happens best when students and staff feel safe both physically and emotionally. We ask that all visitors please check in at the office before proceeding down the hallways or making contact with students.

One concern that all schools have is bullying. Our definition of bullying includes three things. First, someone is intending to cause harm either physically or emotionally to others. Second, there is a power difference between the person causing the hurt and the victim. Third, the same or similar offenses are perpetrated by the same person.

The greatest prevention of bullying is for people to tell authorities what is happening. When students tell an adult, the school is better able to help make sure the bullying doesn't continue. We encourage you to talk to your children about telling adults at school when hurtful things happen to them at school.
