Elementary Magnet Assessment Information for the 2016-2017 School Year**  
Salt Lake City School District's Extended Learning Program (ELP) provides specialized educational services for identified gifted and high ability K-6<sup>th</sup> grade elementary school students. ELP services are available at all district elementary schools with more extensive services provided through ELP Magnet Programs at Emerson, Hawthorne, and Whittier Schools. Parent Information Meetings will be held on Wednesday, January 6 and Wednesday January 13, 2016 at 6:00 pm in rooms 112-114 at the Salt Lake City School District offices. As part of the eligibility process for the 2016-2017 school year, gifted and high ability preschool through 5<sup>th</sup> grade students may participate in the assessments beginning January 6, 2016 through February 19, 2016. Registration is open from November 3, 2015-February 11, 2016. The K-6 Application and Disclosure Statement forms are on the Salt Lake City School District's ELP website.
