### **Principal's Message**

### **Before and After School**

We have been noticing a greater frequency of students coming very early and staying very late. We are seeing students here as early as 6:40, and some not leaving until around 4:00. We do not have supervision for students before 7:30, and are concerned that parents and students who are here very early before school or late after school know that we cannot provide day care services for children before and after school. We do have our extended day program and the Learning Lab that provided programming to work with students, and we are happy to provide those services. However, we cannot watch or be responsible for students and siblings who are here outside of school hours if they are not a part of those programs.

We encourage students and their parents to make plans before school concerning where students will be and what they will be doing after school.

### **Uniform**

We are seeing many students who are not wearing the school uniform. As a reminder, students should be wearing any combination of blue, white, and khaki. We have recently amended the uniform to include blue denim. We have also approved a change that will allow students to wear any clothing that represents a university. We are focusing on having a college culture. We want students to see themselves as future university students. Any article of clothing that represents a college or university is welcome at Mountain View any day of the week.
