1. Welcome and Introductions 8:30
 - a. Baby Henry Wowczuk, born 9/18/2022 Big welcome to Henry from everyone.
 - b. Jordan Bergera, School Social Worker Big welcome to Jordan, Social Worker assigned to MTVE and Glendale this year. She is the school based mental health support. She is a therapist assigned to us to support our students. There are three tiers in the school support. Social workers are considered tier 3 support. If a student is in need, parent approach Natalie Hart for a tier 2 support and she may refer the tier 3 support to Jordan if that is the better fit.

4. House Bill 58, 9:00
 - a. Positive Behavior Specialist: Lacey Herrera This bill addresses e-cigarettes, tabaco, alcohol use, etc. Lacey has worked with the district to implement this plan with our families and students over the next three years. Some of the goals of the program help address mental health needs for our students. The curriculum covers Second Steps, bullying, *Botvin life steps training*, which is a substance abuse prevention program taught in fifth grade, and group and individual counseling. We also have a plan to use three programs: the *Move this World* program, Restorative Circles/Practices, and Zones of regulation. These are all SEL curriculum. We have a few programs we use now: GOTR, Eagles Running Club, Pricipal's 200 Club, Gifted Music Program, Learning Lab, Afterschool Program, 5th Grade Leadership Team, 5th Grade Social Groups, Monthly counselor meetings, monthly counselor lessons during rotations, and the SafeUT App. We have a goal of doing a Red Ribbon Week in the future.
5. Principal's Report 9:10
 - a. 2021-2022 Schoolwide data Acadience is our reading fluency program. Mr Finch went over the individual BOY from 2021-22 vs BOY 2022-23 and shared our goals. Kinder BOY data from last year (2021-22) showing that we had 59% in Red. BOY 2022-23 is 36%. Our 4th and 5th grade take the RI test (Reading inventory). It includes reading fluency and comprehension. Our 4th grade is very low (60% in red). There is a lot of work to do in 4th and 5th grade, as they lost 2nd and 3rd grade to COVID. KEEP scores from our kindergarten scores. Our reading scores are very low compared to previous years. Our math scores are 82% proficiency, which is better than previous years. Our 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade took the RISE. It tests LA for 3rd grade, and LA, math, and science for 4th and 5th. Our science scores are really great, close to pre-pandemic numbers. Our reading and math scores need improvement, and the teachers really feel that. But, we see some students work really hard and improve. And some who don't. Our RISE demographics show that our African American, Asian, and Caucasian categories are smaller in our school because they are smaller groups. Our Hispanic and Pacific Islander categories are larger at our school. Our RISE score demographics show low SES and MLL student's scores, also. Our WIDA test data reflects the scores of our English Language Learners towards proficiency. Our goal is to graduate students in elementary from WIDA so they have space for another class in their middle and high school schedules, rather than an additional ELD class to help them reach proficiency. There were a lot of questions regarding WIDA, also what type of instruction are

these WIDA kids receiving, and how Dual fits into this. Mr Finch addressed these individually. Mr Finch introduce Mrs Nichole Swink as the WIDA admin and teacher who works with this demographic of MLL.
